

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes how the independent developer (“we” , “us” , or “our”) collects, uses, and discloses information in connection with the mobile application Daily Diet (“App”). By using the App, you consent to the practices described below.

Information We Collect

- a. Device information: device model, OS version, language, unique device identifiers (e.g., Android ID, Advertising ID).
- b. Network information: IP address, network carrier, coarse location (city-level).
- c. Usage data: app launches, feature interactions, crash logs, and aggregated analytics.
- d. Information you provide voluntarily: feedback, support requests, survey answers.

How We Use Information

- Provide and maintain the App and its features.
- Troubleshoot bugs, monitor performance, and improve user experience.
- Send service-related notices or security alerts.
- Comply with legal obligations.

Sharing & Disclosure

- Service providers: analytics or hosting partners who process data solely on our behalf and are bound by confidentiality obligations.
- Legal requirements: when required by law or to protect the rights, property, or safety of us or others.
- Business transfers: in connection with a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, provided the recipient agrees to respect this Policy.

Your Rights

You may request access to, correction, or deletion of your personal data, or restrict certain processing, by contacting us at redrockstudios92@gmail.com

Data Retention

We retain personal data only as long as necessary to provide the App and fulfill the purposes described above, unless a longer period is required by law.

Children’ s Privacy

The App is not directed to children under 13. We do not knowingly collect personal data from anyone under 13. If you believe we have collected such data, please contact us and we will promptly delete it.

The App may contain links to external sites or services. We are not responsible for the privacy practices or content of those third parties.

Changes to This Policy

We may update this Policy occasionally. Material changes will be highlighted in-app or via other prominent notice. Continued use of the App after changes constitutes acceptance.
